Why is Global Rescue the best choice for the active traveler? There are several capabilities that set Global Rescue apart from the competition and make us the world's best emergency evacuation and crisis response service.

Field Rescue Capabilities: Global Rescue is the only provider with the ability to reach our members in the field or remote environments anywhere in the world

Johns Hopkins Medicine: Global Rescue has a partnership with the top hospital in the U.S. to provide our members with the best medical advice possible

Field Rescue:

What happens if I am injured while in a remote area and can't get to a hospital? Global Rescue is the only worldwide provider of emergency services with the capability to evacuate our members from the field, anywhere in the world. Our extensive network of aircraft includes both fixed and rotor wing (helicopter) resources that can be launched in as little as 90 minutes from the initial call for service. Our deployable personnel include military special operations veterans, search and rescue experts, and paramedics stationed worldwide who are able to come to our members' aid anywhere. Global Rescue will evacuate our members first to a local hospital for initial stabilization, and if additional hospitalization is required, the rest of the way home to any hospital they choose. ***With any other evacuation service, you have to get yourself to a hospital or airport BEFORE you can receive help.***

What are your capabilities to provide rescues in extreme environments?

Global Rescue is unique in the industry because of who we are. Our Operations teams are comprised of former military special operations personnel (Navy SEALs, Army Rangers, etc.), search and rescue experts, and experienced paramedics. These professionals have spent their careers helping others and saving lives, and accept nothing less than success on every mission. Using these personnel and our global network of aircraft and response teams, we have performed rescues in some of the most extreme environments in the world, from the heights of the Himalayan Mountains down to the depths of the Colca Canyon (the world's deepest). Our missions have taken us into the midst of active war zones, such as Beirut and the Republic of Georgia, areas of terrorism and civil unrest, like Mumbai, or even the middle of African jungles, Arctic forests, Asian mountains, and Middle Eastern deserts. Access is not always instantaneous, but Global Rescue will do whatever it takes to get to you, anywhere in the world.

Medical evacuation services:

If I'm traveling, will Global rescue fly me home on a private plane if I get sick? If you require hospitalization and cannot be treated and released at a nearby facility, Global Rescue will transfer you to the home country hospital of your choice. Global Rescue will determine the mode of transport, taking into account member safety, treatment and comfort concerns. To provide the best possible services to members in need, we will only transport members who require hospitalization on an in-patient basis.

If I'm hospitalized and want to be transported to Johns Hopkins Medicine to receive treatment, will Global Rescue transfer me to a Johns Hopkins Medicine facility? Global Rescue will transport our members to the domestic hospital of their choice, whether they choose Johns Hopkins Medicine or another medical facility. However, Global Rescue cannot guarantee that there will be space available to admit the member. We will do our best to accommodate our member's preferences and work with the receiving hospital to both gain admittance for our member and manage all of the logistics of the transfer.

Security services:

Why should I enroll in the security services membership? If the situation in a country deteriorates to the point where an official declaration is made or it is clear that the member will suffer imminent grievous bodily harm, Global Rescue will deploy and rescue the member, bringing them to the nearest safe location. Global Rescue is the only service capable of providing this level of service.
